Q

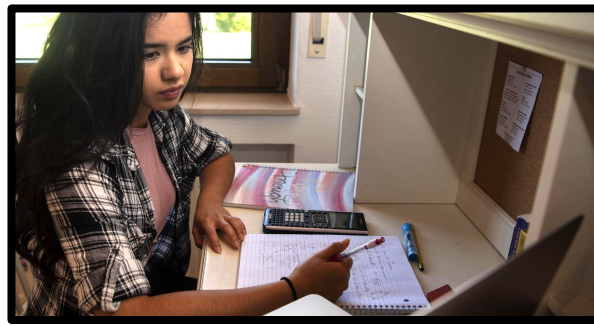
